Course Review 2024 History Level 2

Response to feedback for newly accredited courses first delivered in 2024.

In collaboration with TASC, DECYP implemented a range of significant amendments across the suite of new courses, including <u>History Level 2</u>.

The 2024 <u>Phase 1 Review</u> identified opportunities for improvement, with a particular focus on assessment.

Senior Secondary Provision and TASC developed a matrix to assess the scale and risk of identified issues. Courses were divided in three categories:

- · High priority amendments
- · Moderate priority amendments
- Lower priority amendments

Subject Matter Experts met to validate and provide feedback on the proposed solutions to identified issues (the amendments).

The work requirements for each module mandate too many criteria to be assessed	Splitting criteria proportionately across the modules would allow the creation of assessment tasks that enable students to provide richer evidence of a smaller number of criteria standards. State a minimum word count in work requirements.	
Repetition of elements in criteria	Element 4 of both Criteria 2 and 3 are quite similar and could be merged to simplify the amount of standards. Element 3 of Criterion 3 could be incorporated into Criterion 4. Each element of Criterion 1 could be incorporated into the content-specific criteria to reduce the amount of criteria.	
Module 3 contains too vast study topics	Reduce the amount of study topics required
