## 5 THINGS TO DO ON A WALK

### What you will need:

- A safe space to walk around your neighbourhood.

### What to do:

1. Look at the numbers on the letter boxes and driveways.
2. Search for a bird's nest.
3. Notice the road signs.
4. Comment on the different gardens, trees and flowers.
5. Talk with your child about what you see, hear and notice.

### What learning is happening:

Going outside in nature is important for our wellbeing and general health. Conversations with your child about what you see and hear builds their vocabulary.
