Sample I - What evidence supports the rating (or ratings) the group has given?

On Criterion 2 - the student engages in too much story telling

Student has missed the opportunity to link facts and theories and use a wider range of psychological terms

They are describing some psychology theories and concepts such as eye witness, personality disorder, doubled personality, responsible for actions but not making substantial connections between these and the narrative

Strong discussion between upper C and B but ultimately we thought they had adequate evidence for B on two of three criteria

should be using APA for referencing?

Student has attempted to use consistent in text referencing and sources

spelling and grammar could be better but structure is good

C6 proof reading, APA referencing

On Criterion 2:

- element I and 5 there is evidence of a B
- element 4 were the weaker two at a C level because they are not making the connections between the related ideas and the facts/ideas and theories

Perhaps an assessment rubric would help. The students should not have to provide such a lengthy and confronting narrative. Not enough focus on the psych theories and core theories - this is particularly difficult if they choose a missing persons. APA should be mandated in the course outline

Choosing a missing person case does not allow the student to analyse the psychological theories adequately. This student did have the opportunity to do profiling, but does not do this. More conferencing with teacher re which are good cases

More help for student to select sources which are focused on the psych theories
