- Strong response but no link to the theory.
- Not a strong link to Human-Nature relationships
- Is there evidence to suggest this student has been in class for a year? Could someone with little exposure to the theory do a similar job?
- A reasonable attempt at creating a timeline and comparing historical and contemporary values
- The question doesn't seem to set students up for an A response

Sample I - What evidence would you need to see in order to assign a higher rating (or ratings)?

- -Stronger and more specific link to the theory.
- -Clearly some understanding of the theory but without creating specific links

Sample I - Summary of group consensus with comments to element level if applicable.

- Difficult for a student to write an A response due to the question
- Some understanding but no link to the theory





Sample I - What actions would you recommend for teachers to help the student attain a higher rating (or ratings)?

- Linking response back to the theory.
- It would be better in the question to talk specifically about a theory. This would allow students to discuss and analyse a specific theory as opposed to talking generally about a range of theories

- No link to the theory of Human Nature relationships.
- Minor link to values but overall talking specifically about 'Leave no trace principles' which is criteria 6, not  $7\,$

- Stronger link to the theory.
- Specifically linking to human-nature relationships is key

- Stronger link to the theory of attitudes and beliefs
- A little vague is attempting to apply the values and beliefs to the example 'Cradle Mountain'
- A little shallow in attempting to apply theory.

Sample 3 - What evidence would you need to see in order to assign a higher rating (or ratings)?

- Stronger and more in-depth reasoning to explain how beliefs and values influence attitudes.
- No Peter Martin's Signposts mentioned in there.
- A stronger chronological perspective of how things have changed over time. Mentioned last 10 years, however, this doesn't provide a historical perspective

- The response needs to be stronger and link more closely to Human-Nature relationships.
