Moderation Details for Calibration - Sample 1

Sample 1 - What rating (or ratings) has the group assigned this sample?

Mean = C Range = C- to B+ Assigned = C

Hypothesis is about gender, but this is not included in Introduction or Results. Results should be presented as a graph and have a descriptor.

Sample 1 - What evidence would you need to see in order to assign a higher rating (or ratings)?

For a higher mark, the student needs to have a basis in research in Introduction, that leads to the hypothesis, and then follow this through in Results and Discussion.

For a higher mark, the student could have explained ethical considerations, rather than listing them. Clearer identification of the IV and DV, and communicate in a formal style in this report.

Moderation Details for Calibration - Sample 3

Sample 3 - What rating (or ratings) has the group assigned this sample?

Mean = B/B- Range = C- to A Assigned = C+/B-

Sample 3 - What evidence supports the rating (or ratings) the group has given?

Hypothesis is expressed better than sample 2. IV and DV are explained although they do not match the hypothesis. Demonstrates a sound understanding of research methods.

Sample 3 - What evidence would you need to see in order to assign a higher rating (or ratings)?

For a better mark, this student could have expanded their responses (eg ethics are listed rather than explained and applied to their research).

Moderation Details for Calibration - Sample 4

Sample 4 - What rating (or ratings) has the group assigned this sample?

Mean = A Range = B- to A Assigned = A-

Sample 4 - What evidence supports the rating (or ratings) the group has given?

More sophisticated understanding of research methods than other samples (explain how IV and DV relate to the hypothesis). Provides additional explanation about research methods (eg why this is an experiment), and this flows through each section.

Sample 4 - What evidence would you need to see in order to assign a higher rating (or ratings)?

For a better mark, the hypothesis and IV/DV need to be clearer.
