



Personalised Approach to Learning

Individual students can undertake a VET qualification as part of a personalised planned program of learning. Industry supports this.

Some students have strong passions for a particular industry. General VET delivery in schools for that industry may not have support, but industry does support VET delivery for individual students with clear interests.

As part of a personalised planned program of learning, VET qualifications (including Certificate IIIs) can:

- provide advanced learning and the next step in a pathway
- increase options in rural/remote schools
- provide opportunities for students to engage with learning that aligns with their aspirations
- support student agency

These VET programs must include:

- strong linkages between the school and the industry/employer
- robust career development opportunities

Further industry advice was sought concerning using private Registered Training Organisation (RTO) for these programs. Schools must undertake a quality assurance process of the training to be delivered. This will ensure the outcomes will meet the needs of students and industry. It is vital learners are

able to provide all elements of the qualification. This includes access to practical components such as work placement.
