some appropriate self-correction simple and complex sentences are evident. excellent pronunciation and intonation. there is a degree of fluency and the message is clear although sentences in themselves are delivered with a pace close to authentic, there are very long pauses in between answers

fewer mistakes. increased pace without gaps. consistent self-correction

after lengthy discussion we agreed on a B-, which is what half the teachers gave in the first place

Increase the number of speaking tasks, whether assessed or not assessed. This would give students more experience in having to produce spoken German under pressure. They could also practise set responses more regularly to decrease commonly made mistakes. Encourage students to practise answers to questions out aloud, recording themselves onto their phone. Lots of repetition and practice aloud to build confidence.
